CAR-VETTES



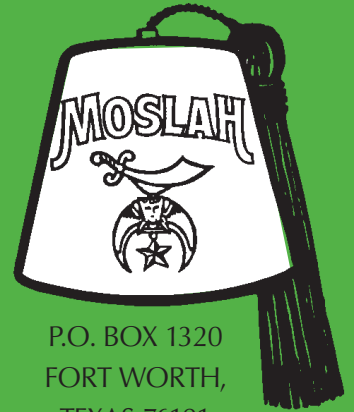
