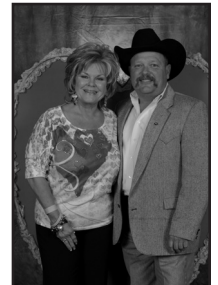

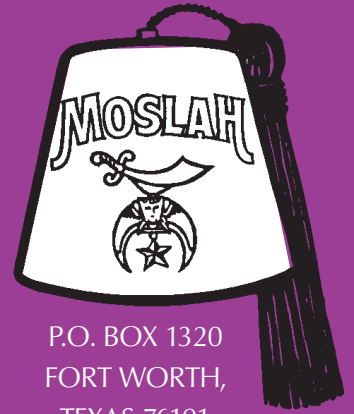
The Mystic Wheels also had a great time at the Shrine Night Out at the Flying Saucer. A great evening of fun and friendship. Thanks to those who put this together.
