

Moslah Shrine History

e have covered the formation of Moslah Temple during the years of 1914 and 1915 and now we need to move forward in time. Nevertheless, it is of some interest to note that Noble Jake F. Zurn was inserted as Potentate in 1915 instead of the 1914 Chief Rabban, Noble William James. Noble Zurn was not an officer in 1914. The Divan progression then moved forward in the usual manner except for Noble C. H. Brown who moved up to Chief Rabban in 1916 and was not heard of again. The reason is unknown. Finally, it is noteworthy that there were 659 members of Moslah Temple as of December 31, 1914. There was also a net increase of 107 Nobles in 1915 for a total of 766 members at the end of that year.

There is very little to report about the year of 1916. Membership increased by 136 to a total of 902 members and the first edition of the MOSLAH'S CUB newsletter or paper was printed. The CUB announced the Ceremonial Session to be held on Monday, March 6, 1916. This paper consisted of a cover and eight pages of excellent quality, even by today's standard in both print and pictures. The edition was VOL. $1-No.\ 1$.




It is interesting to note that the candidates reported to the Moslah Recorder's Office located at 808 American National Bank Building in Fort Worth.






