Potentate's Column

Membership First & Foremost, Always Has Been!



Robert L. Lee, Potentate, into existence on May 14, 1914 under dispensation. Fort

Worth Shriners from Hella Temple wanted their own Temple in Fort Worth and **action was required** to be taken. A group of these Fort Worth Nobles attended a meeting that was called on Monday evening, Jan 5, 1914. "A resolution was presented and carried that the group proceed with circulating a petition for the securing of signatures asking for a Temple in Ft Worth to be presented to the Imperial Council at their meeting May 14, 1914, in Atlanta. It required a minimum of 400 names to obtain a charter. E. J. Hosey was unanimously selected as first Potentate and was named a committee of one to select a name for the new Temple."

"At a regular meeting of Hella Temple, April 16, 1914, about 50 Nobles from Fort Worth being present, a resolution was introduced instructing Hella's Representatives to work and vote for a dispensation for Fort Worth. After considerable discussion the vote was called for by standing vote. Fort Worth Nobles had a good majority, and as we wanted a unanimous vote, we remained standing urging the seated Nobles to arise and make the vote unanimous, which they very kindly did."

It is now May and the year is quickly passing but there is still much work to be done in Membership. It's been 100 years since Moslah came

A committee was formed and 457 signatures were obtained. The committee representing the Fort Worth Shriners left Ft Worth on Sat May 9, 1914 (by train) to the Imperial Council Session in Atlanta, Ga. and "arrived in Atlanta, Monday May 11th at 8:30 AM, together with the Band, Patrol and a couple of Panthers in a cage, provided by Noble Edrington, who was President of the Fort Worth Park Board at that time." The committee consisted of E. J. Hosey, H. E. Crowley, William James and Holt Harris. On May 14, 1914, approval was granted on the floor of the Imperial Council and "Moslah was born." Quotations are excerpts taken from the 1932 Moslah News (Compliments of Dr. G. F. Nemitz, a Moslah Shriner and Member of The Chanters).

For the year ending December 31, 1914, Moslah had 160 creations, 42 affiliations and a total membership of 659, a number which was sufficient for the Imperial Council to grant a full Charter to Moslah on July 13, 2015. The challenge then, as it is today, is growing our membership and action is required by the Nobles of Moslah. This will only be achieved if the membership will make a commitment to bring in new members. Will you make that commitment? Will you take on the obligation to bring in at least one new member to Moslah this year? If you will, Moslah will grow and be successful in both its support of our Fraternity and our Hospitals. The final results are in your hands. Together we can make it happen!

A big THANK YOU to HP & P Phil Trew and his Membership Committee for the dedicated effort they are making to improve our membership numbers and motivating the troops. Membership is by far the most difficult and important task we face

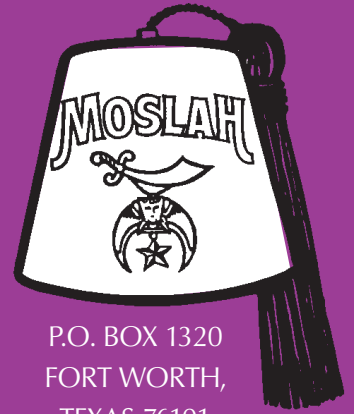
