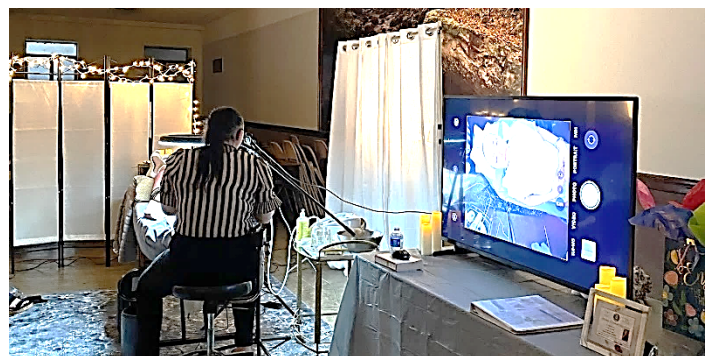

We were proud to have a large number of Mystic Wheels show up and help out at the Easter Egg hunt. A great event in a year of great events!

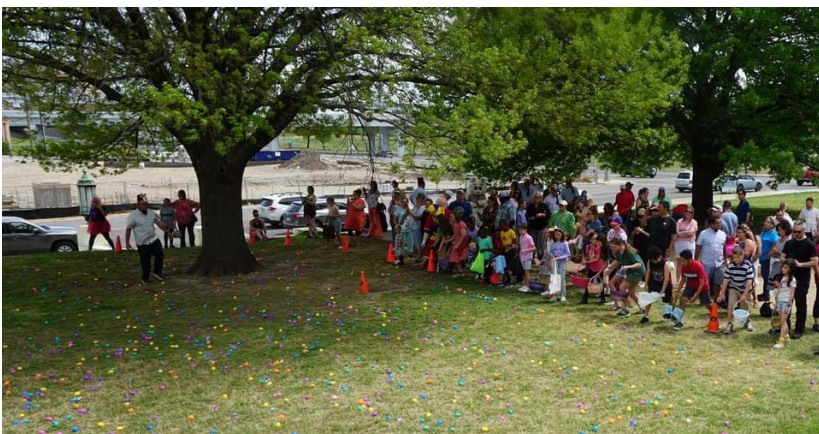

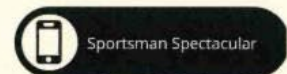

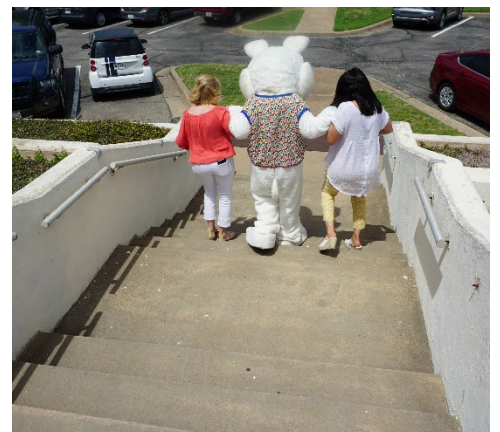
