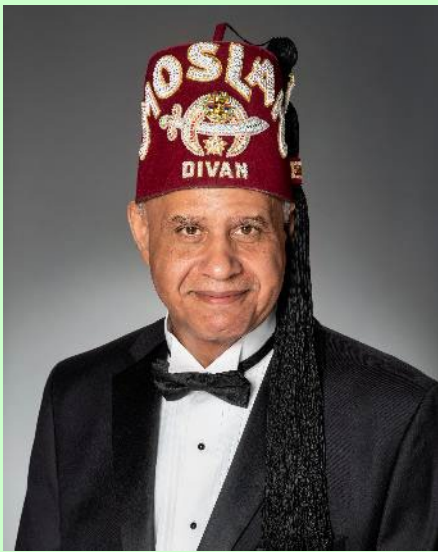

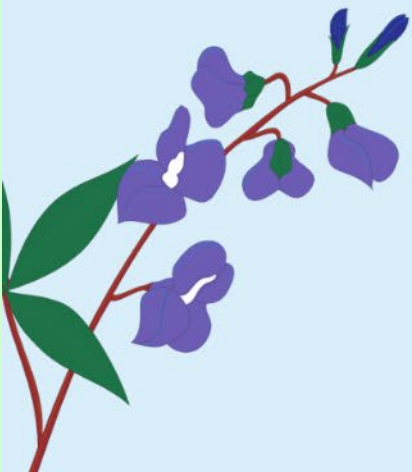

Egypt Club

Research - Settlers in Egypt, Texas were recruited to form Company F of the First Regiment of Texas Volunteers. They joined to help Houston and the Texas army, camped just above Egypt, to keep the Mexicans from crossing the Colorado River. At the Battle of San Jacinto, they formed the center of the Texas line. William Menefee, who signed the Texas Declaration of Independence, Dr. John Sutherland, Alamo courier, and other famous Texans lived in/near Egypt, Texas. The Texas Republic opened "Post Colorado" at Egypt in 1837.

There are 4 towns in Texas established in the early 1800s called Egypt. Three of them are lined up similarly to the Pyramids of Giza Egypt. Also, this is similar to Freemason General William Worth who was stationed in San Antonio where he died in 1849. He was buried under one of three Obelisk lined up like the Pyramids of Giza Egypt. 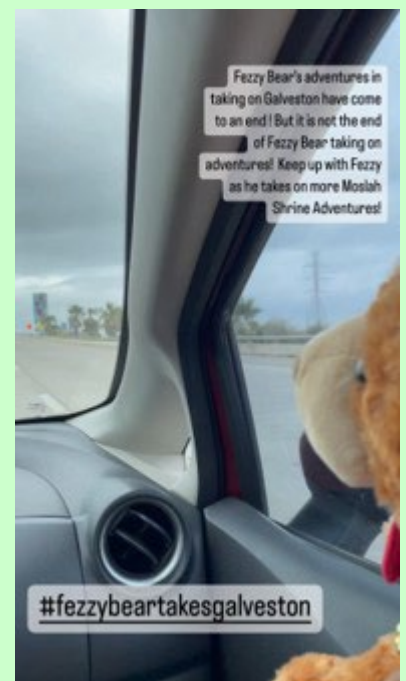
