


### **BE A SHRINER NOW**

## Oriental Guide

Happy New Year to you all. Laura and I are excited to join the Moslah Shrine Divan and look forward to serving you as your Oriental Guide for 2024. We have received overwhelming support from past Potentates, their ladies, and the nobility, and for that, we are blessed.

The OG has many jobs, and outside of taking care of the Potentate, my primary responsibilities are the 100 Million Dollar Club, Blood/Burns, and Temple entertainment. The 100 Million Dollar Club is a Hospital Endowment Fund started by our very own C. Victor (Vic) Thornton II between 1971 and 1972 when he was the Imperial Potentate and, to date, Moslah's only Imperial Potentate. He was also Moslah's Potentate in 1959 and a Past President of the Patrol in 1956. His idea was that every Shriner contribute \$100 to the Fund, and with the membership being around 100,000 in the 1970s, you would have 100 Million Dollars. Well, that number has surpassed his idea of \$100,000,000. Remember that even if you are a member of the 100 Million Dollar Club,

you can sign up your wife, kids, or grandkids, and they will receive a certificate and be a part of the "World's Greatest Philanthropy."

Blood/Burns money goes directly to the Shriners Children's Texas in Galveston where it is used to help save lives. We have 22 Hospitals for Children throughout North America where kids get the best medical care, and the donations help families with little to no health insurance. Our goal this year is to raise \$15,000 for Blood/Burns, and with your help, we can reach this goal. This will be another example of how Moslah Shrine Temple is the greatest Temple in Shrinedom.

Temple entertainment: This year, we are pleased to present three nights to the Nobles and their ladies, where we take care of you, and all you have to do is have fun. This is an excellent opportunity to bring family and friends and let them see how we have fun while raising money for Shriners Children's. On March 1<sup>st</sup>, in the Temple Ballroom, we will have **Movie Night**. The movie will be The Sandlot, rated PG. There will be \$1 hot dogs, \$1 pop/sodas and \$1 snacks. Popcorn and games will be provided. It's a great baseball movie, so come dressed as your favorite ball player! 


# Directors




