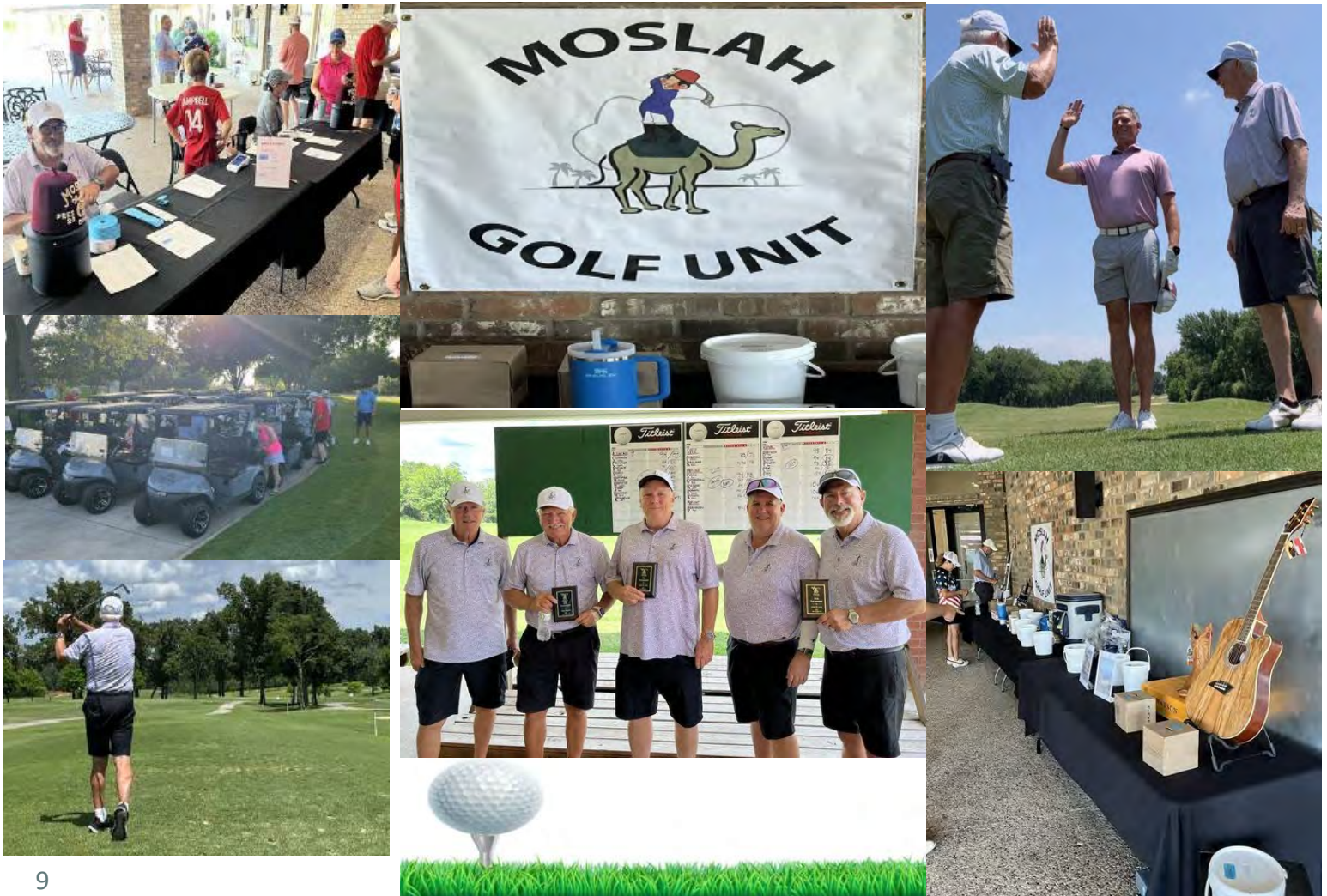
FLYING FEZ
